

**TOWN OF WATERTOWN
NOTICE OF REFERENDUM
SEPTEMBER 16, 2025**

The Electors of the Town of Watertown are hereby warned to meet at their respective polling places in said town on Tuesday, September 16, 2025, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. pursuant to Section 709 of the Town Charter to vote for approval or disapproval of ordinances adopted by the Town Council on August 12, 2025 and entitled “An Ordinance Appropriating \$34,000,000 For Settlement Of Litigation Against The Town In The Case Of City Of Waterbury v. Town Of Watertown And For Related Costs; And Authorizing The Issue Of Bonds Or Notes And Temporary Notes In The Same Amount To Finance The Appropriation” and “An Ordinance Appropriating \$10,000,000 For Various Road Improvements And Related Work; And Authorizing The Issue Of Bonds Or Notes And Temporary Notes In The Same Amount To Finance The Project”. The full texts of the ordinances were published in the Town Times on August 21, 2025, and are on file in the office of the Town Clerk and available for public inspection during normal business hours.

Voting will be at the following polling places:

Voting District 68-01 – Watertown High School, 324 French Street, Watertown, CT

Voting District 68-02 – Judson School, 124 Hamilton Lane, Watertown, CT

Voting District 68-03 - Swift Middle School, 250 Colonial Street, Oakville, CT

Voting District 68-04 - Polk School, 437 Buckingham Street, Oakville, CT

Absentee ballots may be obtained at the Town Clerk’s office and will be centrally counted at Watertown Town Hall, Registrar’s Office 61 Echo Lake Rd.

The ordinances will be placed on the ballots under the following headings, respectively:

“SHALL THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN APPROPRIATE \$34,000,000 FOR SETTLEMENT OF LITIGATION AGAINST THE TOWN IN THE CASE OF CITY OF WATERBURY V. TOWN OF WATERTOWN AND FOR RELATED COSTS; AND AUTHORIZE THE ISSUE OF BONDS OR NOTES AND TEMPORARY NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

“SHALL THE TOWN OF WATERTOWN APPROPRIATE \$10,000,000 FOR VARIOUS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS AND RELATED WORK; AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF BONDS OR NOTES AND TEMPORARY NOTES IN THE SAME AMOUNT TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION?”

Electors approving the ordinance will vote “Yes” and those opposing the ordinance will vote “No”.
